U-4 Division Rules

In the U-4 Division, we have weekly sessions that last one hour. The hour consists of an intra-team instructional session led by the coaches. The U-4 Division is our youngest group. We understand the need for informality and flexibility with children of this age, and our program is intended to provide a fun introduction to soccer within a relaxed and inclusive setting.

In the U-4 Division, there are no games between teams. All sessions are intra-team. In general, these sessions are intended to be instructional and fun. If, however, the coach should decide to try a game-like activity, the children **SHOULD NOT** play the goalie position.

1) Weekly Sessions

- All participants should arrive 15 minutes before game time in order to be ready. For coaches this is absolutely necessary, as you may need to help set up the field so that the session can begin on time.
- We do not encourage additional practice sessions for the U-4 Division.
- Snacks should be provided halfway through each session. Coaches will establish a rotating schedule of who will be responsible for the snack.
- Every child should bring his/her own drink to every practice and game. This is critical.
- All coaches are required to read and abide by CHUSA's Zero-Tolerance Policy. This will be strictly enforced. We encourage and expect the enthusiastic support of all parents for all players.

2) Parents

- Parents should always sit on the sides of the playing fields and never on the ends (behind the goals or end-lines) of the fields.
